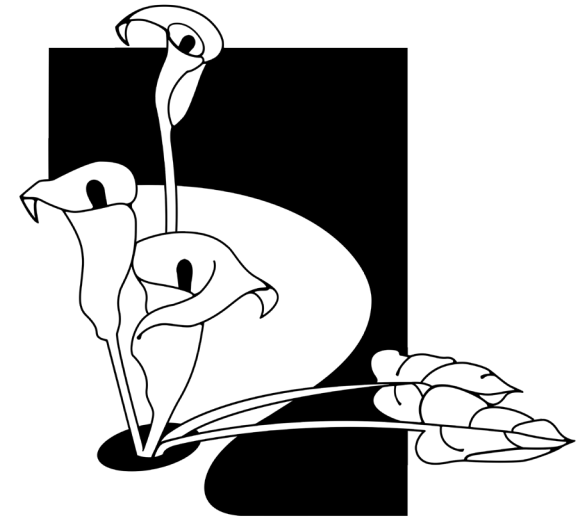

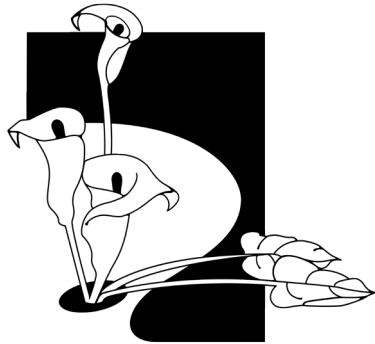

Member Benefits

Organized on July 25, 1951 as the Sacramento Arrangers Guild, the Sacramento Floral Design Guild offers a full schedule of member activities, including:

Monthly Meetings

Meetings are held at the Shepard Garden & Arts Center on the fourth Wednesday of each month from September through May at 10:00 a.m., unless otherwise announced. Each Meeting opens with a business program and ends with a live demonstration by a creative professional in the floral arts.

Workshops

Floral Design Workshops take place monthly on the second Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. from September through May, except December. These hands-on workshops help build our floral design skills and are provided free to members and guests.

Beginner Classes

Beginner Classes are offered to members and guests to teach the basics of floral design taught by an experienced designer. Each class participant creates a unique design to take home. Because materials, including containers and flowers are provided, a nominal fee is charged.

Plant Sales

The Guild participates in semi-annual Plant Sales with other clubs at the Shepard Center and in outreach events. Proceeds from the sale of floral and horticultural designs help support the Shepard Garden & Arts Center and the Guild.

Flower Shows

The Guild participates in various annual flower shows in the Sacramento Region, including shows sponsored by the Camellia Society, the Chrysanthemum Society, and the Rose Society. Members are invited to create competitive designs that showcase the sponsor's flowers.

Floral Arrangements

From September through May, Guild members volunteer to create and display floral designs that enhance the foyer of the Shepard Garden & Arts Center.

Holiday Project

During December, Guild members decorate a holiday tree and the display niches in the Shepard Garden & Arts Center for the enjoyment of holiday visitors.
